The school's safe and caring setting enables students to re-engage, take charge of their learning, and obtain the tools needed to be college- and career-ready. SIATech's family of schools has graduated more than 15,000 previous dropouts since 1998.

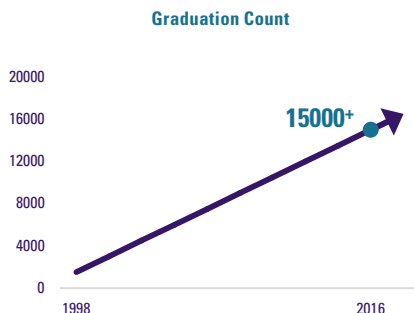

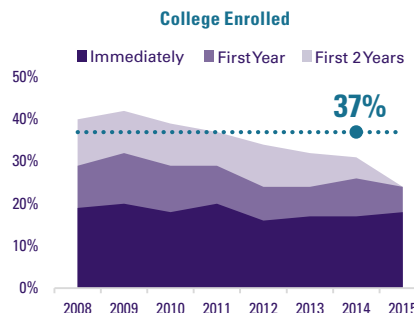
15,000 Graduates and Counting!

SIATech schools have remained focused on dropout recovery since they were established in 1998. SIATech enrolls students throughout the school year in order to welcome students back for a second chance at their education. Students must meet all the state requirements to earn a high school diploma. Students are not charged tuition as the schools are public and free to students. Upon enrollment, each student credit history and interests are evaluated to create a personalized learning plan. 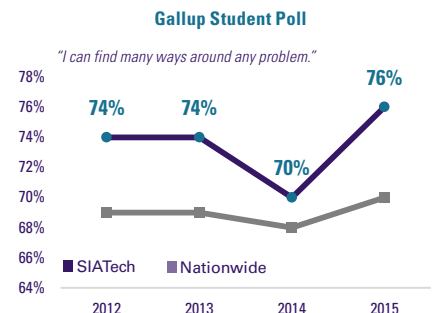
College-Going Rates

SIATech schools provide an environment for students to get ready for college and careers. SIATech students are often the first in their family to graduate from high school. Many had to drop out to help their families earn money in order to make ends meet. For newly enrolled students, it is often unthinkable to them that they will go to college. However, this perspective changes as students progress through the curriculum and build trusting relationships with caring SIATech staff. Within two years of graduation, an average of 37% of SIATech and MYcroSchool graduates will enroll in an institution of higher learning. SIATech is proud of its alumni and support their individualized paths to lifetime goal fulfillment.



Students are Highly Engaged at SIATech

SIATech students are engaged consistently and constantly in their curriculum and classrooms. The Gallup organization surveys schools across the nation annually on measurements of hope, engagement, entrepreneurial aspiration, and career/financial literacy. Gallup's results repeatedly illustrate the many ways SIATech provides an excellent educational environment for its students. Results from the Gallup Student Poll demonstrate that SIATech students frequently give higher responses than student responses in the nationwide sample. In spite of previous difficulties in school, SIATech and MYcroSchool students are back on-track to success.

A MYcroSchool is a community-based, personalized learning program that prepares at-risk students for college and career. There are MYcroSchools in Gainesville, Jacksonville, and St. Petersburg / Pinellas.

MYcroSchools are small learning communities that provide a high school program for students who need to get back on-track to graduation. Rather than viewing students at-risk of failure, MYcroSchools consider students at-promise of success.

This tuition-free public charter high school program engages students through relationship-focused, high-tech, and rigorous learning experiences. Graduates emerge prepared for careers, the military, and/or more education.



RAPSA

SIATech helps teachers take their professional development to the next level no matter where they are on the skill continuum. Its comprehensive offerings help all educators foster continuous improvement—key to guiding an increasingly broad range of learners toward graduation and a successful future.

In 2008, we expanded our outreach by creating RAPSA (Reaching At-Promise Students Association) to sponsor conferences, workshops, webinars, and provide an online resource repository for K-12 teachers, administrators, counselors, coaches, and volunteers of at-risk students.
